Dear Ms Mayer,

RE: Application by Intelligent Inventions Limited for Approval by FEI of Winning Tongue Plate bit (NP design)

We act for Intelligent Inventions Limited.

In 2013, our client submitted its WTP bit (NP design) to you for approval. At the present time the bit is still awaiting approval for use in dressage but has been approved for show jumping and eventing.

FEI has approved an extended plate design WTP bit for show jumping and eventing, although our client did not formally apply for it to be approved. Our client however is grateful for that approval.

We have been asked to write to you on behalf of our client to clarify some design issues over which misconceptions by FEI members may have arisen.

Recent correspondence received by our client from a member of FEI suggests that possibly some members might consider that our client is seeking approval for dressage for the extended plate bit, when it is not.

Our client is simply seeking approval for the NP (normal piece) design which is an oval surround over the joint of the bit.

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To illustrate, we **enclose** 2 photographs, one showing the extended plate bit and one showing the normal piece bit.

We hope that that allays any confusion which may have arisen in respect of that issue.

Secondly, our client has received word through equestrian contacts in Sweden who have contacted FEI, but FEI has an issue over the size of the centrepiece on the normal plate bit, in that it is too large.

Our client wishes to draw to your attention to previously approved bits for dressage. The size of the centrepiece in the traditional snaffle bit, French link snaffle bit and the Neue Schule bit is similar or larger than the size of the centrepiece in the WTP NP bit, as illustrated by the **attached** photographs.

You will of course be aware that there is no FEI rule stipulating that the centrepiece has to be a specific size or dimension.

We ask that you again consider our client's application having regard to these 2 factors.

You have already been provided with many highly-qualified testimonials from leading experts in respect of the WTP NP bit.

Further, the WTP is the only bit to win an Australian international design award.


It seems that most horse people don't want to put their horse into a bit which creates pain and the wonderful award winning feature of the WTP NP bit is that it is a kind and responsive bit and based on the reports prevents bit pinching, roof- rubbing and side- pinching.

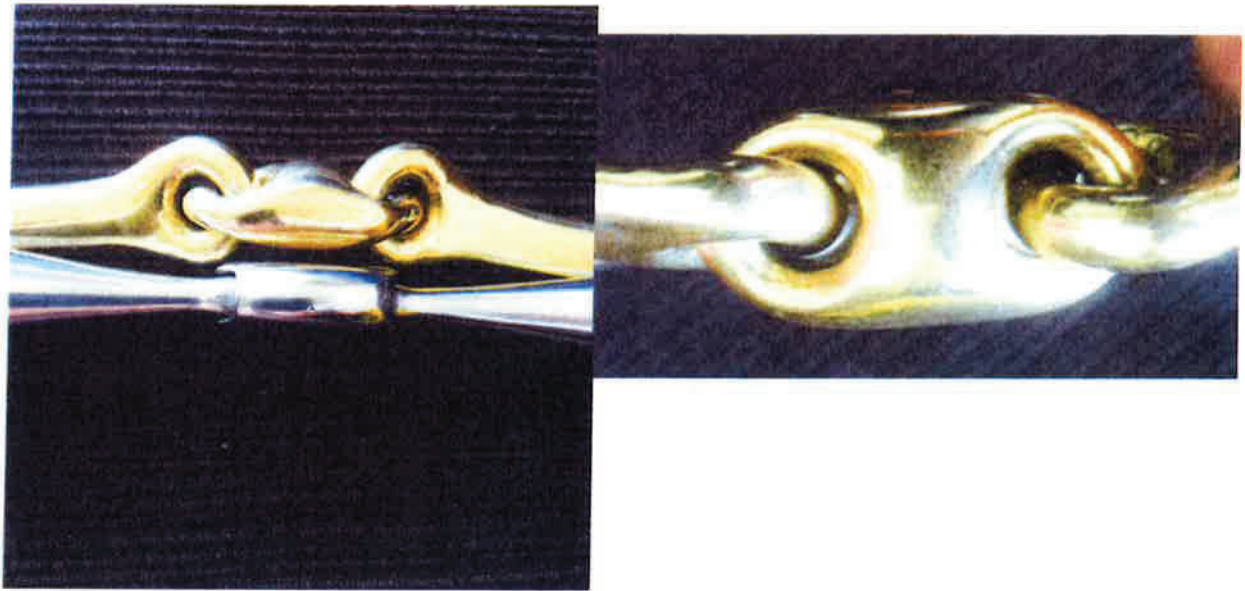

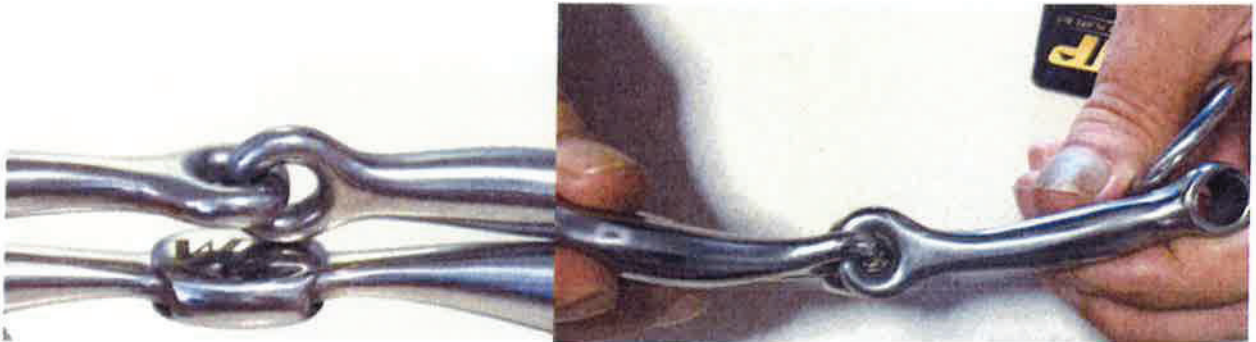
