* ADRV indicates an anti-doping rule violation, in other words confirmation that an athlete has broken anti-doping rules;

* IC indicates 'In Competition'; and OOC indicates 'Out of Competition';

* DCF stands for Doping Control Form;

* TUE stands for Therapeutic Use Exemption;

* Media reports suggest that Prince Chaudhary's ban has been halved, however this hasn't been confirmed.
