- * ADRV indicates an anti-doping rule violation, in other words confirmation that an athlete has broken anti-doping rules;
- * IC indicates 'In Competition'; and OOC indicates 'Out of Competition';
- * DCF stands for Doping Control Form;
- * TUE stands for Therapeutic Use Exemption;
- * LIMS stands for the Laboratory Information Management System retrieved from the Moscow Laboratory;
- * CRA stands for Case Resolution Agreement
- * ABP stands for Athlete Biological Passport
- * CAS stands for Court of Arbitration for Sport
- * PNA is Italy's national anti-doping prosecutor; TNA is Italy's anti-doping tribunal
